

## INFORMATION ABOUT FEES



The typical charges for evaluations are as follows:

### **IQ Testing: \$350**

Involves an IQ test (WISV-IV, WJ-III, or WAIS-III), feedback, and report. Measures overall cognitive skill strengths, uncovers any hidden weaknesses, and provides useful educational recommendations and strategies.

### **Comprehensive Psychoeducational Evaluation: \$1,000-\$1,500**

Includes initial consult session, IQ testing, additional cognitive testing, achievement testing, screening for attention and other learning problems, and review of the student's developmental, medical, learning and social history. Fee will vary depending on the extent of testing needed.

### **ADHD Evaluation: \$600**

Includes developmental, medical, learning, and social history, evaluation of cognitive and neuropsychological factors associated with ADHD, and other emotional factors.

### **Focused Educational Assessment: \$135/per hour**

Involves testing to address a specific question and/or fill in more information from a previous evaluation.

### **Psychoeducational Consultation: \$135**

This includes a review of educational/psychological records and a 50-minute meeting to address whether further testing is needed, accessing special services. A consultation can provide a second opinion regarding previous clinical or school testing.

**The Horizon Academy Testing Center is a fee-for-service clinic, and does not process charges to health insurance companies. Therefore, we request full payment be made at the time of testing. We accept cash, check or credit card (Visa, American Express, MasterCard or Discover). We will provide you with an itemized receipt for your records and for you to submit to your insurance company.**

He currently serves as a consultant to the Missouri Board of Law Examiners, and has served on the professional advisory board of the Kansas Learning Disability Association and the board of the Kansas-Missouri International Dyslexia Association.

Testing will vary from case to case, but may include testing of attention span, impulsivity, executive functioning, memory and fluid reasoning skills, plus the assessment of academic, social and emotional functioning.
